Latest trends

Tariffs applied on fishery products by the United States of America are having a strong impact on the world market. As of August 2025, a 50 percent tariff rate on most Brazilian fish exports sent shockwaves through the country's fisheries and aquaculture industry, which normally ships between 70 and 80 percent of its fishery products to the US market. Over 1 000 tonnes of fish in 58 containers were retained at Brazilian ports immediately after the announcement. The tariff threatens around 20 000 jobs in Brazil's fishing sector and could make premium products like lobster, tuna and croaker unviable for US consumers. Brazilian producers are scrambling to find alternatives, including seeking emergency credit to stay afloat. At the same time, they are exerting pressure on the authorities to intensify negotiations aimed at reopening the European market which has denied access to Brazilian fisheries and aquaculture products since 2017.

Also in August 2025, the United States announced a 15 percent tariff on most fisheries and aquaculture product exports from the European Union. This rate includes both the Most Favoured Nation (MFN) tariff and an additional "reciprocal" tariff introduced under the US-EU trade framework. While the European Union agreed to eliminate tariffs on US fisheries and aquaculture product exports, the United States maintained its 15 percent tariff rate on EU-origin products, including salmon, cod, shrimp, squid and lobster.

Like the European Union, fisheries and aquaculture products from Norway became subject to a 15 percent tariff rate in August; in that month, the value of total fisheries and aquaculture product exports from Norway to the US market fell by 3 percent compared with the same month last year.

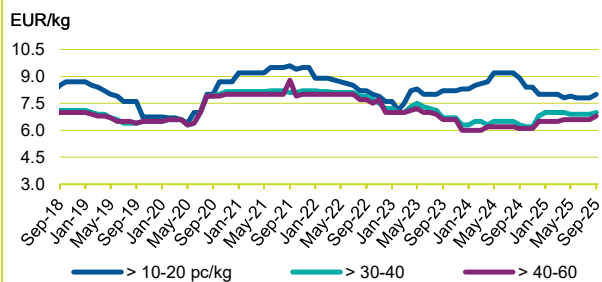
Crustaceans

Recent updates from Indonesia indicate that the restocking of shrimp ponds is taking place, albeit with less shrimp fry being released into the ponds. This is because farmers, facing a 19 percent reciprocal tariff with the United States, are trying to avoid being forced to lower price levels in the future due to market pressure.

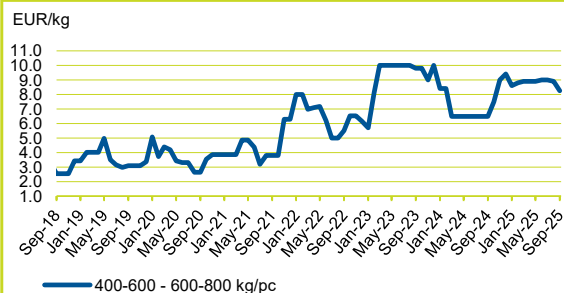
The market continues to hold steady for European crab this month. Demand is mostly moderate and reflects typical seasonal patterns for September.

Supply of European lobster is strong at the moment, which is a normal feature for this time of the year. As a result, and also due to slow demand at the moment, prices have declined sharply. For some sizes, declines of more than EUR 10.00 per kg were reported.

CRAB - in France, origin: Europe





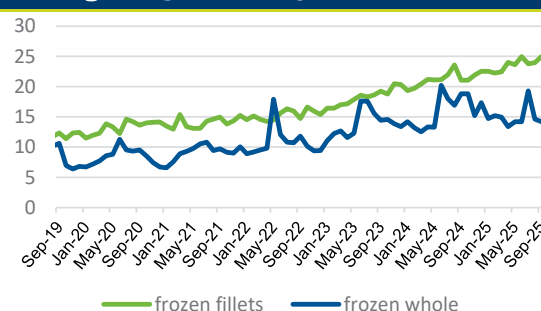
Small pelagics

The main season for North Sea herring fishing is now over. Available figures show that the same amount of North Sea herring has been landed in Norway so far this year as in the corresponding period last year (130 000 tonnes).

Norway exported 14 244 tonnes of herring worth NOK 298 million (USD 29 million) in August 2025. The value fell by 3 percent, compared with the same month last year, while there was a 1 percent increase in volume. Germany, Poland and Denmark were the largest markets for Norwegian herring this past August. This year, however, more of the herring has gone to direct human consumption and less to the production of fishmeal and fish oil. So far this year, 80 000 tonnes have been used for consumption, compared with 66 000 tonnes in the same period last year, an increase of 33 percent.

August has become an important month for mackerel fishing in Norway, and there has been great excitement about how the start of the 2025 season would turn out. With a significantly lower quota and a continued tight supply of mackerel globally, it was expected that prices would trend upwards. In August 2025, approximately the same volume of mackerel was caught as in the same month last year, at 56 000 tonnes.

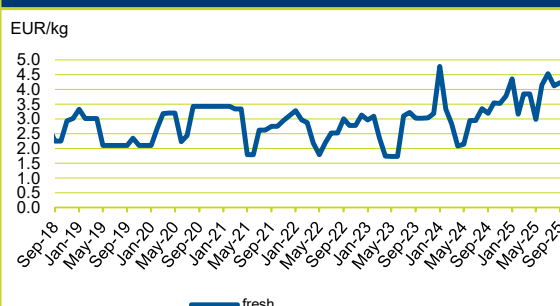
Herring - origin: Norway

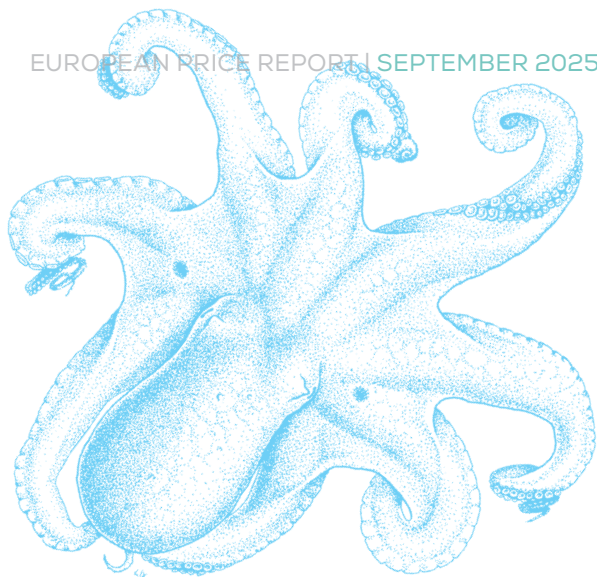


Mackerel - origin: Norway



Mackerel - in Italy, origin: France





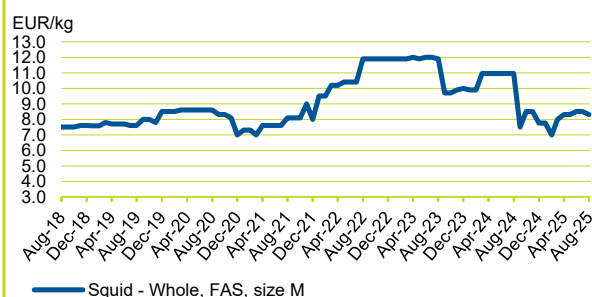
Cephalopods

Squid catches in South Africa continue to be weak, leading to low coldstorage holdings in the country. The prices of the limited supplies available are going up by EUR 0.30 per kg.

Octopus fishing in Indonesia is just about to start after the rainy season. However, some areas of the country are still experiencing rain and unpredictable weather conditions. Fishers are facing tight competition due to an ongoing price war and better catching prospects. Once the windy weather subsides, octopus catches will rise.

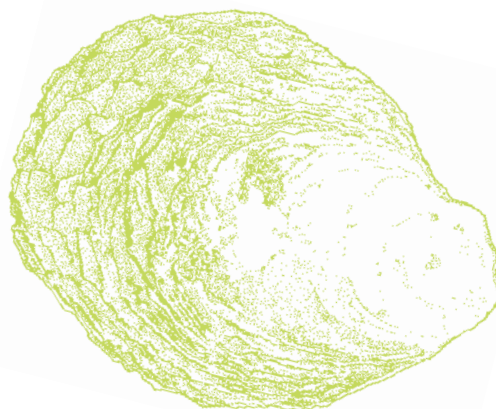
Cuttlefish is in plentiful supply in the European market, and prices have been declining sharply since last month. Decreases in price levels of up to EUR 2.00 per kg are being experienced in Mediterranean markets.

SQUID - in Italy, origin: South Africa

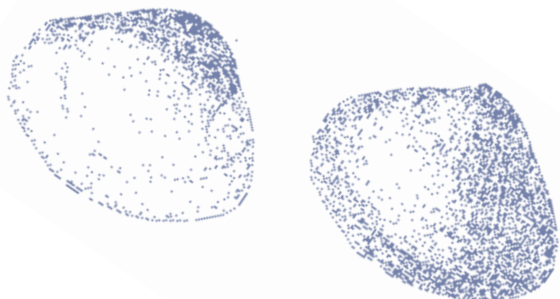
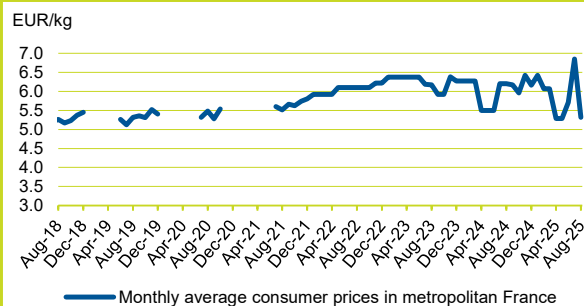


Bivalves

Farmed clams in Italy (*Ruditapes philippinarum*) continue to be in very limited supply due to the well-reported invasion of blue crab in the main producing areas. Prices of these clams are going up tremendously; in just one month the increase was EUR 3.00 per kg, or more than 30 percent.

Tuna

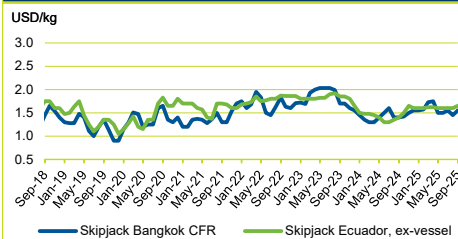
The Western and Central Pacific is home to the world's largest tuna fishery. Tuna fishing in the region is holding steady in 2025, but with some cautionary flags. Skipjack tuna (which accounts for 57 percent of global tuna catches) is in healthy condition. Yellowfin and bigeye tuna stocks are stable but under pressure, with some regions showing signs of localized overfishing. South Pacific albacore is being closely monitored, with interim Target Reference Points (TRPs) set to manage fishing effort.

Approximately 91 percent of global tuna stocks are not currently overfished, thanks to stronger regional oversight and science-based quotas. However, Pacific bluefin tuna remains overfished, and bigeye tuna in parts of the Indian and Pacific Oceans is still vulnerable. The use of Fish Aggregating Devices (FADs) is rising; these can increase catch efficiency but also contribute towards juvenile stock depletion.

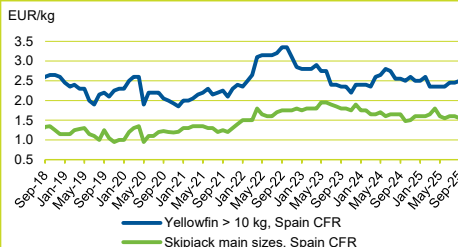
The Western and Central Pacific Fisheries Commission (WCPFC) is implementing Harvest Control Rules and more precise stock assessments to guide sustainable fishing. There is a push for precautionary approaches, especially in areas with data gaps or uncertain stock trends.

Tuna fishing in the Western Pacific is largely sustainable for now, especially for skipjack, but ongoing vigilance is needed, particularly for bigeye and bluefin. The region's future hinges on how well management bodies enforce quotas and adapt to changing ocean conditions.

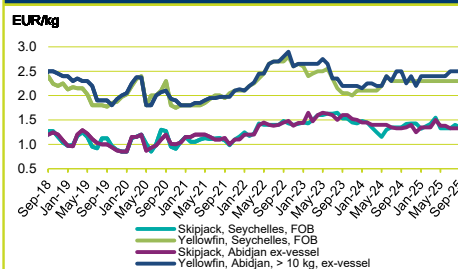
TUNA - Pacific Ocean



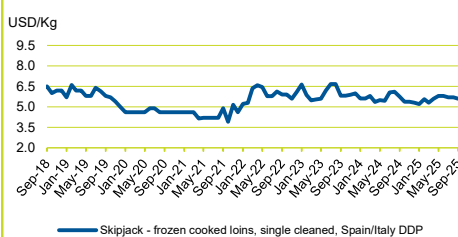
TUNA - Spanish canneries

Groundfish

2025 has been characterized by low quotas for important species such as cod and at the same time, saithe fishing is weaker than last year. This has led to very high prices in domestic sales, which in turn has affected the industry in Norway and markets abroad.

Norway exported 1 842 tonnes of fresh cod worth NOK 134 million (USD 12 million) in August 2025, down by 6 percent and 21 percent in value and volume respectively, compared with the same month last year. Denmark, the Kingdom of the Netherlands and Lithuania were the largest markets for fresh cod in August 2025. With regard to fresh wild cod, a significant decline in the export volume was noted, due to lower catch quotas. On the other hand, export volumes of fresh farmed cod increased by 6 percent to 817 tonnes, while export value rose by 26 percent to NOK 59 million (USD 5.8 million). Farmed cod accounted for 44 percent of the export value of fresh cod in August 2025.

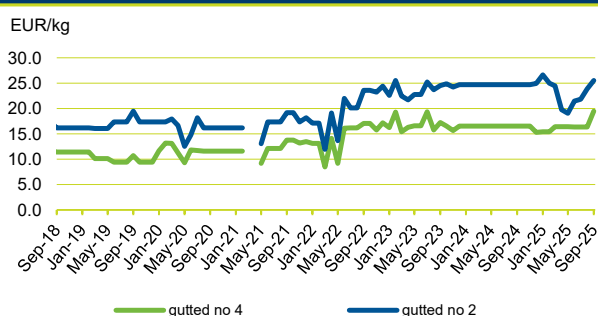
Norway exported 2 057 tonnes of frozen cod worth NOK 182 million (USD 18 million) in August 2025, representing declines of 6 percent in value and 24 percent in volume year-on-year. China, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, and Lithuania were the largest markets for frozen cod in August 2025. For the first time since January this

year, China is the largest market for frozen cod, taking over from Norway.

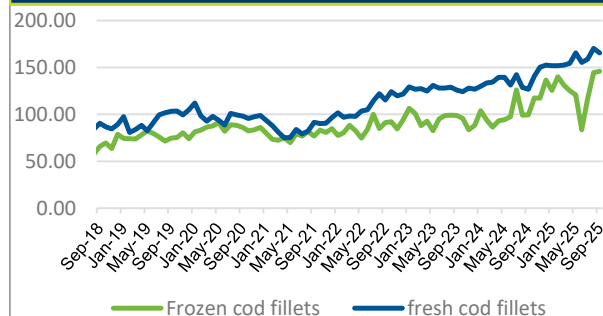
Due to the reduced fishing quotas for both *Gadus morhua* and *Gadus macrocephalus*, there is difficulty in finding raw material, causing prices to rise. Recently, thanks to the cold winds from Siberia that are blowing towards southern Europe, there has been an increase in the consumption of this product, which is mainly linked to traditional winter recipes. Further price increases are likely in the coming months. Stockfish prices increased by EUR 4.00 per kg to reach EUR 30.00 per kg.

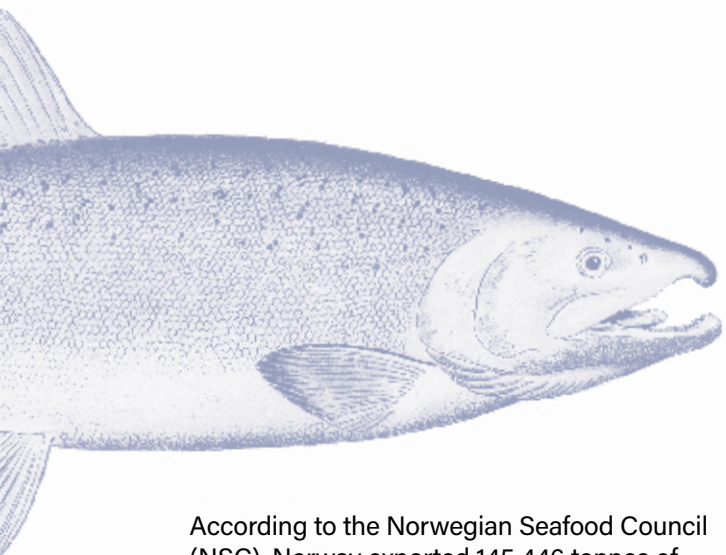
Norway exported 5 439 tonnes of clipfish worth NOK 509 million (USD 49 million) in August 2025, up by 18 percent in value compared with the same month last year, while the volume fell by 18 percent. Portugal, the Dominican Republic and Brazil were the largest markets for clipfish this August. Portugal is in fact, consolidating its position as Norway's largest market for clipfish made from cod due to relatively strong economic development and record-high tourism in the country. However, low cod quotas are also creating challenges; with the price of clipfish rising higher than ever, fewer Portuguese are eating the product than in the past.

According to the Norwegian Seafood Council (NSC), Norway exported 145 446 tonnes of salmon in August, worth NOK 10.6 billion (EUR 910 million). This represented a decline of 1 percent compared with the same month in 2024, despite a 17 percent increase in export volume.

Poland, the United States, and the Kingdom of the Netherlands remained the main destinations for Norwegian salmon. Exports to China showed the strongest growth, with value increasing by NOK 349 million (EUR 30 million), or 84 percent, compared with August 2024. Volumes to China reached 9 343 tonnes, up 114 percent year-on-year. Despite this sharp increase, China was the fourth-largest market in terms of export value, accounting for around 7 percent of the total. Poland retained the top position, with 14 percent of exports.

NSC analysts highlighted that, in a period of global uncertainty, the diversification of Norwegian salmon exports across roughly 100 markets remains a strategic strength, as no single destination is the dominant market.

Favourable production conditions this past summer have contributed to historically high harvest volumes of both salmon and trout. However, this has put downward pressure on export prices, particularly for fresh whole salmon, which reached its lowest average price in August 2025 since September 2022.

The US market presented more challenging conditions in August 2025. Following the 15 percent tariff increase on Norwegian and European seafood introduced on 7 August, the overall value of Norwegian seafood exports to the US market declined by 3 percent compared with the same month last year. Salmon exports fell more sharply, down 15 percent. For fresh whole salmon specifically, export value to the US market decreased by 51 percent.



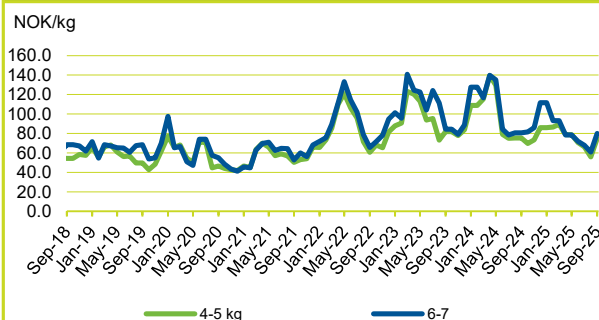
Salmon

According to the NSC, several factors are influencing this downturn. Norway now faces higher tariffs than key competitors such as Canada (which is exempt) as well as Scotland and the Faroe Islands, both of which are subject to a 10 percent tariff. At the same time, production has increased in other salmon-producing countries with more favourable access to the US market, intensifying competition. The strengthening of the Norwegian krone against the dollar in August also lifted export prices in that market.

While the United States has traditionally been a premium-paying market for fresh whole salmon, demand dynamics are shifting. Strong growth in Asia (particularly in China), combined with limited supply of larger fish, has redirected part of the global trade flow away from the United States. Analysts note that Norwegian producers remain highly adaptable and accustomed to developing new markets, though the adjustment process is more demanding for smaller companies and for other species within the seafood sector.

NSC data disseminated by the Undercurrent News Price Portal show that prices for HOG fresh Norwegian salmon, FOB at the border, reached NOK 66.36 (EUR 5.66) in week 35. This represented a slight decline compared with the previous week and left prices broadly stable relative to late July. The trajectory since week 30 has been marked by alternating gains and losses, reflecting a generally volatile trend without a clear upward recovery.

Salmon - origin: Norway



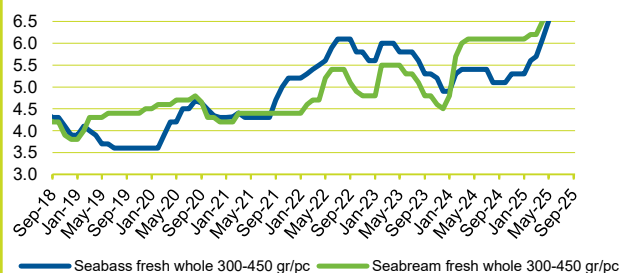
Seabass and seabream

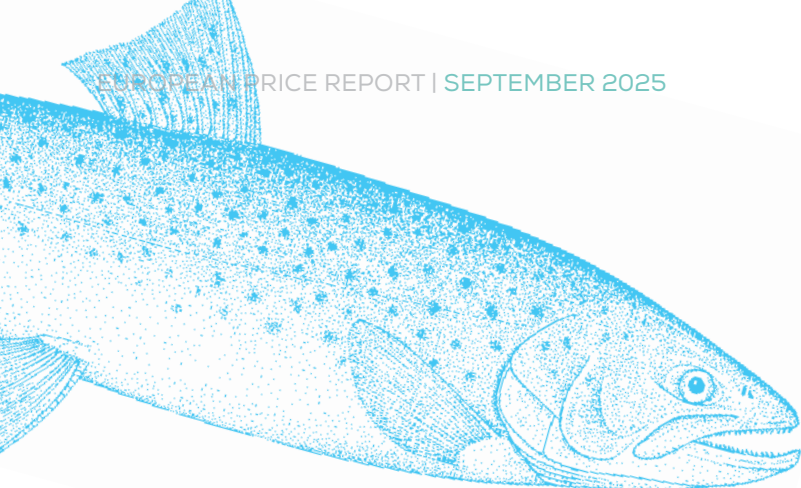
Seabass prices are stable for small specimens (under 450 g) and big specimens (over 800 g). Medium-sized seabass prices have increased by EUR 0.30 per kg, reflecting strong demand from the HORECA trade.

The seabream market in Germany is projected to grow consistently through 2030, with increasing revenues and volumes across both fresh and processed segments. Online retailing is expanding rapidly in Germany, catering to convenience-driven consumers and boosting access to fresh and value-added seabream products. Health-conscious buyers are drawn to seabream's lean protein and omega-3 profile, reinforcing its appeal in urban and affluent demographics. Imports from Türkiye and Greece continue to dominate, supported by modern aquaculture practices and sustainability certifications. Organic seabream is gaining traction, especially in premium retail and B2C channels. Prices remain stable, with seasonal fluctuations tied to size and origin.

EUR/kg





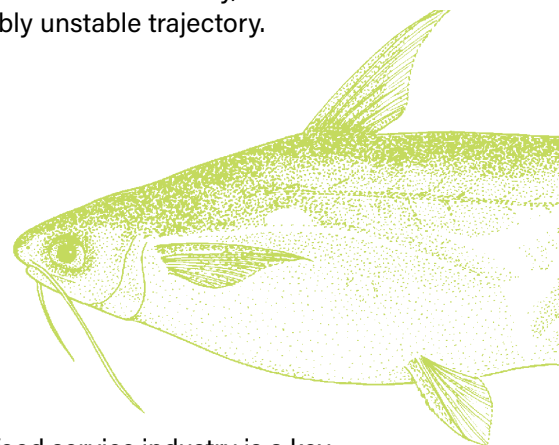
Trout

According to the Norwegian Seafood Council (NSC), August was a weak month for trout exports. Norway shipped 8 907 tonnes worth NOK 638 million (EUR 54.8 million). This represented a decline of NOK 124 million (EUR 10.6 million), or 16 percent, compared with the same month last year, while export volume fell by 6 percent.

Ukraine, Lithuania, and the United States were the main destinations for Norwegian trout in August. Viet Nam, however, stood out as the strongest growth market, with export value increasing by NOK 16 million (EUR 1.4 million), or 167 percent, compared with August 2024. In

addition, shipments reached 367 tonnes, up 186 percent year-on-year.

NSC data disseminated by the Undercurrent News Price Portal indicate that prices for HOG fresh Norwegian trout, FOB at the border, have shown marked volatility in recent weeks. After peaking at NOK 68.26 (EUR 5.73) in late July, values dropped sharply at the beginning of August before recovering and briefly surpassing NOK 70 (EUR 5.98). By week 35, the price stood at NOK 68.24 (EUR 5.82), almost the same level as at the end of July, but reached through a notably unstable trajectory.



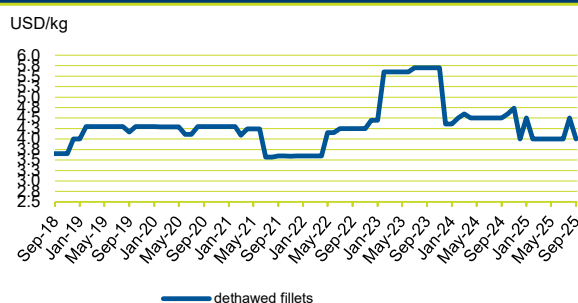
Freshwater fish

The tilapia market in the European Union is relatively small but evolving, shaped by import dynamics, consumer preferences, and sustainability concerns. Domestic production is negligible; there has not been significant investment in tilapia farming mainly due to climatic conditions. The European Union is therefore a net importer of tilapia, sourcing primarily from Asia (China, Indonesia and Thailand) and Latin America (Costa Rica and Honduras). Frozen fillets are the most common import format, catering to food service and retail sectors.

Germany is the fastest-growing EU market, particularly for fillets. Tilapia's mild flavour, affordability, and high protein content make it

attractive. The food service industry is a key driver, especially in multicultural urban areas and ethnic cuisine segments. However, tilapia sometimes faces scepticism due to concerns about farming practices abroad. Innovative uses, for instance, in processed foods or pet feed, are emerging but remain niche.
